To ensure a continuous programme is able to remain certified and therefore able to use the albert logo on their end board, we require that a Carbon Footprint and Carbon Action Plan is completed to cover a 12-month period from the date of preapproval. The production then must recertify each year in order to continue to display the logo. (The 12-month period does not have to be January -

Year on year we would expect to be able to see a clear reduction in carbon emissions over time.
